DECREE

Considering the Decree of recognition of the association *Couples for Christ* as an international private association of the faithful, with a juridical personality, and the approval of the Statutes for five years *ad experimentum*, granted on March 11, 2000 (Prot. N. 470/00/S-61/B-91);

Having examined the request presented on September 27, 2004 by Mr. Frank Padilla, *Couples for Christ* Director, to receive the definitive approval of the Statutes of the above mentioned association by this Dicastery;

Valuing the opportunity of approving definitely the Statutes of the Association *Couples for Christ*;

Accepting the modifications made to the Statutes in force;

In light of art. 131-134 of the Apostolic Constitution *Pastor bonus* for the Roman Curia, and canon 312 §1, 1°, of the Code of Canon Law, the Pontifical Council for the Laity decrees:

1°) The confirmation of the recognition of the association *Couples for Christ* as a private international association of the faithful, with a juridical personality, according to canons 298-311 and 321-329 of the Code of Canon Law.

2°) The definitive approval of the Statutes of the above mentioned association, that have been appropriately modified, duly authenticated by this Dicastery and deposited in our Archives.
