WORSHIP

- Final Cut Pro (for Mac) or Adobe Premiere (for PC) to edit video
- Audacity (free audio editing software)

3 steps to create household worship videos:

1. Create "backtrack" (main music minister records themselves with guitar and vocal)
2. Backtrack is sent to rest of music min and they record themselves with video while listening to the backtrack in headphone/airpod/etc so only they can hear backtrack
3. Edit all video and compile into one video. Keep video simple so as to not create a distraction

- Master all the important features of the online meeting platform you are going to be using. This will help the actual CLP event run more smoothly. Zoom is the platform used in SoCal.
- Designate a person to be in charge the online platform logistics during the actual CLP event (takes care of break out rooms, muting/un muting people, assisting with speakers and their presentations, etc)
- Designate a "fellowship team". This team is in charge of ice-breakers for each CLP session, keeping sessions fun & light, encouraging interaction between the participants and CLP team
